Youth Agricultural Incentives Program (YAIP) is a cost share program designed for applicants that are enrolled in elementary, middle, high school or home school, that are at least 9 years of age by January 1, 2018, and are actively engaged in agriculture. Applications will be available at the Clark County Conservation District Office at 667 Tech Drive starting Tuesday, February 12 until Tuesday, March 5, 2019 during the hours of 8:30 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
